

Soup Sisters and **Broth Brothers** are year-round programs where participants pay a registration fee to participate in a soup-making event at a local professional kitchen under the guidance of a chef facilitator. Each event produces approximately 150-200 servings of nourishing soup that are delivered fresh to a local shelter. Events are social evenings with lively conversation, chopping, laughter and warm kitchen camaraderie that culminate in a simple, sit-down supper of soup, salad, bread and wine for all participants.

The participation fee is not considered a donation to the Soup Sisters non profit organization. We are MISO - money in soup out. The fee covers the costs for use of the venue, equipment, supervision, ingredients for the soups, a Chef or professional facilitator and a culminating meal with wine at every event.
